

GLEN CANYON PARK FIELD TRIP
Friday September 25, 10:30-noon

Schedule: Please meet up from the corner of Elk and Chenery Streets at 10:30 am, where the dirt road leads into Glen Canyon Park (directions attached below). Because parking is limited, you are encouraged to carpool or to take public transportation. You can find out more information about Glen Canyon Park by following the links on the class website.

What to Bring: Please bring a notebook and pencil/pen. Plan on attending rain or shine.

Assignment: In a brief paper, please describe what makes Glen Canyon a unique ecological area in San Francisco and why it needs to be preserved. Also propose a management goal for one particular species in this park. The assignment is due in class on October 29.

Directions:

By car: From campus, head north on Phelan Avenue until you reach Judson. Turn right on Judson and then head straight until you take a left on Circular Avenue. Turn left onto Congo St, then left onto Elk.

By Bart: Go to **Glen Park Station**. Make a right on Bosworth (uphill). Make a left on Elk Street. This is a 10-15 minute walk.

By Bus: Muni bus lines #44 and #52 will take you to the corner of Elk and Bosworth. Walk on Elk toward Chenery with the park on your left.
